Keys Public Schools COVID-19 Event Guidelines

“Red County Designation” (Basketball)

1. All individuals who enter a Keys Public Schools facility must wear a facial covering. All non participants of the activity must continue to wear the facial covering at all times, failure to do so could result in removal from the contest.
2. No concession or hospitality room will be provided while Cherokee County is in the “Red” designation on the OSSBA COVID Map.
3. The first two rows of seating behind the bench and scorer’s table will be unavailable for seating. All table personnel will wear a facial covering at all times.
4. The bench area will be spaced out to maximize social distancing and teams are recommended to limit total personnel to 15 or less.
5. KPS proudly promotes sportsmanship, post game handshakes will not take place.
6. Visiting teams will be offered a locker room area as well as specific warm-up basketballs. There will be no “halftime shooting” by a boys team during the halftime period of the girls game.
7. The bench area will be sanitized between games and the game ball will be sanitized before play and again at halftime.
8. Keys will allow 5 cheerleaders on the floor and no visiting cheer squads will be allowed while Cherokee County is in Red Designation.
9. Spectator Rules: Keys fans will be limited to 4 per participant and visiting fans will be limited to 90 tickets. All fans who enter must have a ticket or an OCA/OSSAA card. Families must sit as a family unit and participants not participating will be asked to sit together in a designated area.
10. All individuals must exit the campus at the conclusion of the game. Individuals should not gather in the cafeteria or any other locations.
